I wanted to pass along an additional note from Wayne Elson of our Air Program Office regarding the Knik Arm project --

As we mentioned in our scoping letter regarding air toxics, it is important to identify any sensitive receptor locations with respect to construction, operations, and maintenance of the project. Diesel emissions may be significant due to the earth moving requirements of the project. If constructed, the Knik Arm project could potentially be a portfolio project under the West Coast Collaborative to decrease diesel emissions (<http://www.westcoastdiesel.org/>).
